## Non-Competition Enforceability Thresholds for 2022

As per RCW <u>49.62.040</u>, the department of labor and industries required to adjust noncompete enforceability thresholds annually to account for inflation using the consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical workers index. These thresholds determine whether a noncompetition clause or agreement is enforceable. There are two thresholds, one for employees (RCW <u>49.62.020</u>) and one for independent contractors (RCW <u>49.62.030</u>). The table below shows the new calculated figures.
